## 1. SNU Global Scholarship

### [Eligibility]

International students in both undergraduate and graduate programs

### [Details]

- Undergraduate Scholarships
  - Number of Recipients: Approx. 80 students
  - Subsidies: Tuition fee, living expenses, and housing fees
  - ※ The amount of scholarship varies depending on individual circumstances.
- Graduate Scholarships
  - Number of recipients: Approx. 160 students
  - Subsidies: Tuition fee, living expenses, airfare, and housing costs
  - ※ The amount of scholarship varies depending on individual circumstances.
  - Additional funding is available for eligible international students who seek to master Korean Language
  - Additional funding is available for eligible international students who require academic support

## 2. Graduate Scholarship for Excellent Foreign Students (GSFS)

### [Eligibility]

Asian students (excluding Chinese and Japanese nationals) in specified graduate programs (subject to change every semester)

- ※ Check the list of programs eligible for the scholarship

**[Number of recipients]** Approx. 20 Graduate Students

### [Subsidies]

- Tuition fee: Full tuition exemption for a maximum of 4 semesters
- Living expenses: 500,000 KRW per month (subject to the offer made by individual colleges)

### ● Selection Period

During admission period for international students every semester



- **Selection Procedure**

Submit scholarship application to the Office of International Affairs → Selection by individual colleges based on admission documents) → Admission

### 3. Silk-Road Scholarship

**[Eligibility]**

Humanities and Social Sciences including Korean language, history, culture, politics, and economics

**[Number of recipients]** About 5 new graduate students

**[Subsidies]**

- Tuition fee: Full tuition fee exemption for a maximum of 4 semesters
- Living expenses: A maximum of 600,000 KRW per month for 4 semesters
- Airfare: A maximum of 1 million KRW for one economy round trip
- Korean language training fee: Fee exemption at the Language Education Institute

- **Selection Period**

During admission period for international students every Fall semester

- **Selection Procedure**

Submit scholarship application to the Office of International Affairs → Selection by individual colleges based on application and admission documents → Admission

### 4. Glo-Harmony Scholarship

**[Eligibility]**

International students from the developing countries in the DAC list of ODA Recipients

**[Number of recipients]** To be announced (TBA)

**[Subsidies]**

- Subsidized Period: A maximum of 8 semesters for undergraduate students, a maximum of 4 semesters for masters' students, and a maximum of 6 semesters

for Ph. D students

- Undergraduate program: Full tuition exemption and 600,000 KRW per month of living expenses
- Graduate program: The level of subsidy is determined by Samsung Dreams Scholarship Foundation

● **Selection Period** January and July

● **Selection Procedure**

- 1) Newly admitted students: Submit application to the Office of International Affairs → 1st document Screening → 2nd Interview by the Samsung Foundation → Admission
- 2) Existing students: School recommendation → report · interview screening by the Samsung Foundation → Admission

## 5. Asian Universities Network Scholarship

### [Eligibility]

Seven universities in Asia (Current list of qualified universities include Sakhalin State University, National University of Mongolia, Vietnam National University – Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam National University – Hanoi City, Chulalongkorn University, University of Laos and Yanbian University)

[Number of recipients] 8 students

### [Subsidies]

- Sakhalin, Mongolia, Vietnam, Thailand and Laos: Full tuition exemption for the Language Education Institute for one year and 600,000 KRW of living expenses per month
- Yanbian University
- 1) Tuition fee: Full tuition exemption for 4 semesters for masters program, and 6 semesters for Ph. D program
- 2) Living expenses : 500,000 KRW per month for 5 semesters for masters program and 7 semesters for Ph. D program
- Airfare: A maximum of 1 million KRW for one economy round trip

● **Selection Period** January and June

● **Selection Procedure**

## 6. Overseas Koreans Scholarship (Undergraduate Programs)

### [Eligibility]

Overseas Korean students who wish to take undergraduate degrees in universities in Korea

[Number of recipients] Approx. 5 students

### [Subsidies]

- Full tuition exemption for a maximum of 8 semesters
- Living expenses: 800,000 KRW per month
- Airfare for one economy round trip
- Korean language training fee: Fee exemption at the Language Education Institute for 8 months
- Insurance fees

- **Selection Period** March

Submit applications to Korean Embassy → 1st Screening by Korean embassy → Selection by the Overseas Koreans Foundation

## 7. Overseas Koreans Scholarship (Graduate Programs)

### [Eligibility]

Overseas Korean students who seek to undertake graduate degrees in universities in Korea

[Number of recipients] TBA

### [Subsidies]

- Full tuition exemption
- Living expenses: 800,000 KRW per month for 4 semesters

- Insurance fees: Approx. 30,000 per month
- Settlement expenses aid upon initial arrival: 500,000 KRW (one time payment)
- Airfare for one economy round trip
- Language training expenses: 2 semesters

● **Selection Period** March and September

● **Selection Procedure**

Submit applications to Korean Embassy → 1st Screening by Korean embassy → Selection by the Overseas Koreans Foundation

## 8. Global Korea Scholarship (GKS) – Korean Government Support Program for Self-Financed Student

[Eligibility]

Self-financed international students in their 2nd, 3rd and 4th year (Overall GPA and previous semester's GPA must be over 80 out of a possible 100)

[Number of recipients] TBA

[Subsidy]

- About 6 million KRW (500,000 KRW per month)
- Period: About 12 months

● **Selection Period** Around February

● **Selection Procedure**

Submit documents to the Office of International Affairs → Selection by the National Institute for International Education → Admission

## 11. Korean War Memorial Foundation Scholarships

Direct descendents of international Korean war veterans who applied to study

undergraduate or graduate programs in Korea and recommended by the Korean War Memorial Foundation

[Number of recipients] 3 students

[Subsidies]

- Tuition fee: Full tuition exemption
- Dormitory fees: Subsidized by SNU
- Living expenses: 500,000 KRW per month

● **Selection Period** Start of every semester

● **Selection Procedure**

Recommended by each college → Admission by the Office of International Affairs

## 12. Korean Government Scholarship Program (KGSP)

[Eligibility]

All areas offered by the universities designated by the National Institute for International Education

[Number of recipients] 300 graduate students and 100 undergraduate students

[Subsidies]

- Full tuition fee: Tuition exemption for 8 semesters for undergraduate program, 4 semesters for masters program, 6 semesters for Ph. D program
- Living expenses: 800,000 KRW per month for undergraduate students, 900,000 KRW per month for graduate students
- Airfare : One economy round trip
- Korean language training Fee: One year
- ※ Korean language training is mandatory and when the student does not achieve TOPIK grade 3 within a year, she/he is not eligible to enter the degree program
- Others: Medical insurance, research fund for graduate students, thesis printing fees, settlement and returning expenses

● **Selection Period**

Undergraduate program in October, Graduate program in January

● **Selection Procedure**

Applicants must choose one of the following application methods

### 13. SNU-Woongjin Global Multicultural Scholarship

#### [Eligibility]

Undergraduate and graduate exchange students from developing nations in Asia. Preferences will be given to those majoring in engineering and natural sciences

[Number of recipients] 10 students

#### [Subsidies]

- Tuition fee waiver: Exchange students are exempted from SNU tuition fee
- Living expenses: 600,000 KRW per month for undergraduate students, 700,000 KRW per month for graduate students
- Airfare: One round trip
- Tuition fee for Evening Korean Language Class at the Language Education Institute
- Period: One semester or one year

● **Selection Period** During the exchange student application period each semester

● **Selection Procedure**

Recommendation by partner universities → selected by the Office of International Affairs

### 14. Global Korea Scholarship (GKS) for Exchange Students

#### [Eligibility]

Scholarship programs for incoming exchange student from developing countries

The National Institute for International Education announces the number of nominees per university each year

#### [Subsidies]

- Tuition fee waiver: Exchange students are exempted from SNU tuition fee
- Living expenses: 800,000 KRW per month
- Airfare: Actual expense of one round trip airfare within the limited range of each country
- Settlement aid: 200,000 KRW (one time)
- Medical insurance
- Period: One semester or one year

● **Selection period** During the exchange student application period each semester

- Period : One semester or one year

- U.S.A: M.I.T, UC Berkeley, Harvard University, Princeton University, California Institute of Technology, Stanford University, Yale University
- U.K.: University of Cambridge, University of Oxford

- Full tuition fee
- Limits of USD 20,000 per year
- Airfare: One-time Return Economy fare

- **Selection Period** Around April each year

### 3. Government Scholarship for Study Abroad

Holders of university degrees in Korean universities or equivalent whose grade is 80 percentile or higher

#### [Subsidies]

- Living expenses: Subject to change depending on the country
- Airfare: One round trip airfare
- Period: 2~3 years (U.S., Canada, U.K: 2 years / Other countries: 3 years)

● **Selection Period** Around May each year

● **Selection Procedure(the National Institute for International Education)**

Submit application → document Screening → in-depth interview → Admission

### 4. Taiwan Government Scholarship for Language Training

#### [Eligibility]

Current undergraduate and graduate students recommended by the university president who wish to study in Taiwan

[Number of recipients] One person per university

- Awarded with NT\$ 25,000(approximately 1 million KRW) each month for one year
- Period: One year

● **Selection Period** Around February each year

Submit application → 1st Selection → submit 2nd Application → Interview → Admission

- Award Approx. 2 million KRW per semester
- Period: One semester or one year

● **Selection Procedure**

Selection by the Office of International Affairs based on submitted documents

## 6. Long-term Overseas Research Fellowship

[Eligibility]

Current Ph. D. students, who wish to undergo research training in prestigious universities for more than 6 months (excluding BK Program students)

[Number of recipients] Approx. 10 students each semester

[Subsidies]

- Airfare and living expenses
- Period: Six months

● **Selection Period** Beginning of every semester

● **Selection Procedure**

Applications submitted by student → Selection by individual Colleges → Admission by the Office of International Affairs

- 1st selection: Document screening
- 2nd selection: Interview by the selection committee (including language test of the training country)

## 7. Short-term Overseas Fellowship

[Eligibility]

- Currently registered students at SNU who wish to undergo research training during Summer and Winter recess (Students in absentia or students completing the program are not eligible to apply)
- Current overall GPA must be 2.7 or higher for undergraduates and 3.3 or higher for graduate students (If it is the first semester of graduate school, undergraduate transcript of entire years is required)
- Practical training for students in School of Medicine, Dentistry and Nursing are



possible

[Number of recipients] Approx. 150 students per year

[Subsidy]

· 1,2 million~2 million KRW

● **Selection Period** May and November of each year

● **Selection Procedure**

Application by student → each college → Admission by the Office of International Affairs

## 8. American Alumni Association Scholarship

Students with excellent academic achievements who wish to register summer programs in prestigious US universities

● **Selection Period** April

● **Selection Procedure**

Application by student → Admission by the Office of International Affairs
