




1. History

Jun	1915	Founded as Chosun Pharmaceutical School (Chosun Yakhak Kangseup So), the First Pharmacy School in Korea (Founder: Cho, Joong Woong)
Jun	1919	Became Chosun School of Pharmacy (Chosun Yakhak Kyo)
Apr	1930	Became Kyungsung Pharmaceutical Junior College (Kyungsung Yakhak Chunmoon Hakkyo) under the Japanese Regime
Aug	1945	Reformed as Private Seoul College of Pharmacy
Sep	1950	Became affiliated with Seoul National University (SNU) and became SNU College of Pharmacy
Jan	1951	Held lectures in temporary classes in Busan till July, 1953 during the Korean War; Transferred back to Seoul in September, 1953, along with the return of the government
Aug	1959	Exchanged the location with the College of Music as a part of the University plan
Jun	1960	Completed the construction Building #1 (Pharmaceutical Research Building) (Yeongeon-dong, Jongro-gu)
Nov	1962	Completed the Building #2 (Pharmacy Education Building) (Yeongeon-dong, Jongro-gu)
Jan	1967	The Department of Manufacturing Pharmacy was added to the College
Oct	1967	Founded the Medicinal Plant Garden as an affiliated body
Mar	1969	Completed the Building #3 (Applied Pharmacy Building) (Yeongeon-dong, Jongro-gu)
Aug	1975	Relocated to the Gwanak campus, Silim-dong, Gwanak-gu (21-dong, 6570 m²)
Mar	1981	Founded the Research Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences
Mar	1981	Founded Model Pharmacy as an affiliated body
Mar	1983	Founded SNU College of Pharmacy, Educational Research Foundation (Kyoyook Yeonkoo Jaedan)
Sep	1985	Established the Medicinal Plant Garden in Daeya-dong, Shiheung, Gyeonggi-do
Jun	1988	Founded the Continuing Education Center for Advanced Pharmacy

Mar	1991	Founded the Research Center for New Drug Development (Korea Science and Engineering Foundation appointed research center)
Feb	1992	Completed the Pharmaceutical Research Building (29-dong, 3590 m²)
Apr	1995	Relocated the Medicinal Plant Garden to Sulmoon-dong, Goyang-si, Gyeonggi-do
Jun	1996	Established the Medicinal Plant Garden in Sanbang-ri, Paju-si, Gyeonggi-do
Feb	1997	Completed the Animal Research Building (141-dong)
Sep	1999	Began the BK21 Human Life Sciences program
Dec	2000	Completed the Manufacturing Pharmacy Practice Building (142-dong)
Sep	2001	Natural Products Research Institute was merged with the College of Pharmacy in accordance with the reformation of all research institutes in the University
Nov	2005	Completed the Explosives/Combustibles Solvent Storage Building
Apr	2006	Began the 2nd stage of BK21 Applied Pharmaceutical Life Sciences Research Division program
Feb	2008	Relocated the Natural Products Research Institute to the Gwanak Campus (20-dong)
Mar	2009	Began the 6-year program
Apr	2010	Completed the Clinical Pharmacy Building (17-dong in the Yeongeon Campus)
